From grand statements to quiet board decisions, these spaces are built to make your program shine—and make your logistics team smile.

## **TERRACE BALLROOM**

The largest ballroom in the Northeast—55,408 sq. ft. of column-free space (yes, football-field size)—can be used as one dramatic room or divided into four salons for general sessions, mega-banquets, or exhibit-adjacent activations.

## **GRAND HALL**

The historic 1892 train shed—the only remaining Victorian-era train shed in America—delivers a soaring backdrop for registrations, head-turning receptions, cybercafés, poster sessions, and press moments.

## **BROAD STREET ATRIUM**

Dramatic glass-and-steel prefunction (23,400 sq. ft.; 113-ft ceiling) made for openings, sponsor lounges, registration, and high-energy networking.

## **MICHAEL A. NUTTER THEATRE**

Purpose-built 600-seat theater with 4K projection, 7.1 surround, and a 58' x 14' stage—ideal for keynotes, film screenings, and special events.

## **EXHIBIT HALLS A-E**


Five halls totaling 528,000 contiguous sq. ft. on one level; elevated loading docks and drive-in ramps keep move-in fast and off city traffic.


